# TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The project shall be Substantial Complete within three hundred thirty (330) calendar days from the effective date of Notice-to-Proceed. The project shall be Final Complete within three hundred sixty-one (361) calendar days from the effective date of the Notice-to Proceed. Liquidated damages will be assessed at the rate of \$2,500 per calendar day.

## AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM CONTRACT PROVISIONS

The proposed project is part of a Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act undertaken by Marquette County in accordance with terms and conditions of a grant agreement between Marquette County and the Federal Aviation Administration, and under provisions of the Airport and Airway Improvement Act, as amended.

The Contractor must incorporate the following Contract Provisions for AIP projects; Buy American Preference, Foreign Trade Restriction, Davis Bacon, Affirmative Action, Government Wide Debarment and Suspension, Government Requirements for Drug-free Workplace.
